One of the stated purposes of the West Islip Robotics Booster Club is to support and foster a student's interest in science and technology. To continue FIRST's philosophy on a local level, the West Islip Robotics Booster Club will award a scholarship to a graduating senior of the West Islip High School. Applicants should have been a member of the West Islip High School Robotics Team 871 for at least one year, and be continuing their education at a 2 or 4 year college in the area of science or technology.

One scholarship will be issued each year, the amount determined annually by available funds. The scholarship will be made as a grant directly to the student and payable upon demonstration of registration at a post secondary institution in the field of science or technology.
